TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

Beginning Tuesday, February 19th, Lostant School District will partner with Illinois Central School Bus. Some route times may change. You will be contacted soon if your route time is going to change. Pat and Rae will remain the bus drivers for Lostant students. A substitute will drive Rae's route during her maternity leave. Lostant school buses will remain in use for the remainder of this school year. The drivers will no longer have cell phones. All calls must now go through Illinois Central's dispatch center. Bus Discipline

Student discipline for bus infractions will continue to be the responsibility of Lostant School District. Two cameras, instead of one, will now be placed on every bus. Cameras will have audio and visual taping capabilities. Behavior infractions will be viewed by Illinois Central Bus Service personnel as well as Dr. Malahy. After viewing any and all student behavior bus issues, Lostant School will manage the discipline.
