## Communication

It is extremely important that all families have contact with teachers. Our teachers are making many attempts to email, text, call, or use digital means to contact you. We do not want to give incomplete grades. If a week has passed and you have not been in contact with a teacher because you do not know how to contact someone, please call me directly. Teachers are doing everything they can to contact you. I will help you get in contact with the teacher regardless of the hour of the day or day of the week.

## Assignment Packets \#1 and \#2

## Packet \#1:

By now students should have completed all assignments in Packet \#1 and placed any paper assignments in the Assignment Bin located at the front door of the school. These assignments were not graded. They were used to gauge what the students could complete on their own or with online teacher assistance.

## Packet \#2:

The assignments in Packet $\# 2$ are due May $1^{\text {st }}$. You may place all completed paper assignments in the Assignment Bin located at the front door of the school on April $23^{\text {rd }}$ or April $24^{\text {th }}$ and April $30^{\text {th }}$ or May $1^{\text {st }}$. The bin will be brought in on May $1^{\text {st }}$ at noon so please make sure all assignments are turned in by noon.

## Assignment Packet \#3

Packet \#3:
We are going to create assignments in Packet \#3 for each individual student. Our plan is outlined below.

1. No assignments for the week of May $4^{\text {th }}$. Teachers will use this week to create Packet \#3.
2. Teachers will assess all work that is turned in on or before May $1^{\text {st }}$. Each student will receive individual assignments for the remainder of the school year based on completed work from Packets \#1 and \#2.
3. Packet $\# 3$ will be delivered on Friday, May $8^{\text {th }}$.
4. There will be 10 days of work in the packet (online or paper/pencil). These assignments will be for the dates May $8^{\text {th }}$ through May $21^{\text {st }}$. These assignments will be individually planned based on each student's completed work to date.
5. The Assignment Bin will be placed at the front door of the school on May $14^{\text {th }}$ and $15^{\text {th }}$, and again on May $20^{\text {th }}$ and $21^{\text {st }}$. The last 10 days of work (Packet \#3) may be placed in the bin on any of those 4 dates.
6. All assignments whether digital or paper/pencil will be due on May $22^{\text {nd }}$.
7. There will be no assignments the week of May $25^{\text {th }}$.
8. Memorial Day is May $25^{\text {th }}$ and the last day of school is May $29^{\text {th }}$.

## Textbooks, Workbooks, Laptops, Library Books, Classroom Books

All textbooks, workbooks, laptops, library books, and teacher classroom reading books must be delivered back to school on or before May $22^{\text {nd }}$. You may place these items in the Assignment Bin or call the school to schedule an appointment to bring these items back.

## Grades, Report Cards, Awards and the School Calendar

A lot of time must be spent analyzing student work that has been or will be completed from March $17^{\text {th }}$ through May $21^{\text {st }}$. It must be determined if your child completed assignments to the best of their ability; rushed through assignments just to get them completed; or did not attempt to complete assignments. We know how much assistance your child needs in the classroom. We must determine how well your child mastered the assignments based on review information or new information we assigned. The only expectation we have is that your child attempts to complete all assignments to the best of his or her ability. The teachers and I will be spending considerable time on this task during the week of May $25^{\text {th }}$ through June $1^{\text {st }}$. We must be absolutely sure we pass your student based on good effort to complete assignments. An incomplete grade will be given if assignments are not attempted or it appears a student did not contact the teacher for help or questions. Incomplete work must be completed over the summer and turned in before July $1^{\text {st }}$. Students who receive an incomplete grade and do not complete the work by July $1^{\text {st }}$ will repeat the course or entire grade next school year.

Report cards will be mailed the week of June $8^{\text {th }}$. The 2020-2021 School Calendar will be mailed with report cards. Awards and certificates for $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester may be picked up in the school office over the summer or during registration on July $31^{\text {st }}$.

## Office Hours

As the Coronavirus continues to spread, we believe it is in your best interest that we stay healthy and available to you.
