2022-2023 Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services

- Return to full in person learning.
- School will be in session 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with breakfast served 8:15 – 8:25 a.m.
- Masks:
 - Optional mask wearing.
 - None required for the onset of the school year.
 - Students and staff will follow orders from the I.S.B.E. and/or Governor's Executive Orders as required.
- Athletic programs will run as normal with full activity fees charged and admission charged at indoor, home sporting events.
- The district will be prepared to adjust educational and athletic programming as necessary throughout the year.
- Remote learning will only be available under one of the following conditions:
 - The ISBE or Governor's office mandates a school closure.
 - Lostant School takes an emergency day (weather related or building issue).
 - A student is diagnosed with Covid-19 or a variant and must be quarantined.
 - A student is quarantined because he or she lives with a person who presents with a serious illness and cannot be exposed to Covid-19 or a variant.
- Parents should keep their children home from school if they are sick or exhibiting symptoms.
- Good hand hygiene will continue to be practiced at all grade levels.
- Students in grades k – 8th will be issued their chromebooks for daily use and in the event of remote learning.
- Field trips and fundraisers will be considered by the Board of Education on an individual basis.
- Locker rooms will be utilized for PE. Students in 7th – 8th grades will wear required PE uniforms.
- Parents should begin planning for Remote Learning Days and day-care should the district be forced to close school due to high numbers of Covid-19 or other strains of the virus in the school.
- Please do not send your child to school if he or she has been sick during the night or is sick in the morning. You are putting everyone at risk of becoming ill.
- Five excused mental health days are allowed.
- The school psychologist is available to meet with any student who needs social, emotional, or mental health support.
- Please contact the principal for a list of LaSalle County agencies that may be of assistance with food, clothing, and health needs.
